

OUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Since the fall of 2016, the History Committee of the George Washington Carver Regional High School Alumni Association (GWCRHSAA, Inc.) has:

- Provided guidance to officials from Culpeper County to renovate the original library space for a new museum
- Mounted and displayed **NINE** exhibits throughout the region with in-kind contributions and grants from the Northern Piedmont Community Foundation
- Contracted with an alumnus, **J. Hubert Jackson**, who painted a **FABULOUS MURAL** for the new museum
- Contracted with a curator, **Terry Miller**, who developed the new museum and prepared all of our exhibits
- Developed two “virtual exhibits” that are on our website throughout our “Digi-See” program funded with grants from the Northern Piedmont Community Foundation
- Given guidance to Culpeper officials to prepare a **Memorandum of Understanding** that guarantees our stewardship of this landmark museum
- Developed an archive and continuously solicit items to enhance the community’s ability to examine and research photographs, documents, newspapers, etc. that focus on African Americans in our targeted counties.
- Begun discussions with officials from the four counties (Culpeper, Madison, Orange and Rappahannock) for long-term financial support
- Hosted a **FANTASTIC PREVIEW OPENING** on October 12-13, 2018, for our alumni and friends with a new exhibit, **Journey: The Class of 1949**
- Begun a video oral history program with funding from the Northern Piedmont Community Foundation
- Hosted a **GRAND OPENING** of the **Carver 4-County Museum** on February 22-23, 2019, and inaugurated a new exhibit, **Origins**
- Hosted a new Homecoming exhibit on September 28, 2019, entitled, **ATHLOS**, about the athletic programs, coaches, cheerleaders and marching band at Carver from 1948-68
